A Bit of History

Constructed in the late 1860's, as the Philadelphia House, 125 Bridge Place is a rare example of Italianate Style, not to be found elsewhere in Stockton or the San Joaquin Valley. A 2-story brick addition was constructed in 1870, and in 1909 this south addition received a third floor and a new front facade. This structure is also noteworthy as it is the oldest building standing at the Head of the Channel; the sole reason for the establishment of Stockton in its present location.
